

Criteria for Awarding Stipends to Students Attending SWAM's Annual Doctoral Consortium

There will be limited number of stipends made available to those graduate students who have a paper accepted to the conference, who register for the conference, and who participate in the doctoral consortium at the conference. To be considered for a stipend graduate students must indicate their interest in receiving a stipend by informing the Program Chair for the Annual Meeting and their respective Track Chair. It is recommended that students indicate their interest via email.

The order of priority for awarding the stipends is as follows:

- 1) Doctoral students with sole-authored papers
- 2) Doctoral students with co-authored papers (all authors are Doctoral students)
- 3) Doctoral students with co-authored papers (authors include Doctoral students and faculty)
- 4) Masters students with sole-authored papers
- 5) Masters students with co-authored papers (all authors are Masters or Doctoral students)
- 6) Masters students with co-authored papers (authors include Masters and Doctoral students, and faculty)

Please note that should there be an insufficient number of stipends available to meet the request of interested students, the Program Chair will determine the awardees by listing the order in which the students made their interest known to him/her, in addition to using the criteria noted above
